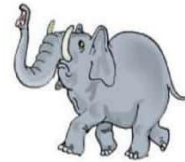
WILD ANIMALS IN DANGER

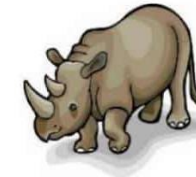
