# New Zealand ASEAN Scholars

- Closing date: 22 April
- English Language Training, Post-graduate certificate, Post Graduate Diploma, Master & PhD = up to 50 across Indonesia annually
- Priority subject areas: agriculture development, disaster risk management, public sector management, private sector management
- Applicants from eastern parts of Indonesia (e.g. NTT, NTB, Maluku, Papua etc) are “particularly welcome”

# Scholarship Eligibility

- Indonesian citizen
- two-year working experience
- having a strong commitment to public, private or civil society sector, the development of Indonesia
- returning home upon the completion of the study to contribute to Indonesia's social and economic development
- be available to take the scholarship in the year of the scholarship offer

# Conts...

- satisfying the admission requirements of NZ institution
- meeting the criteria of Immigration NZ requirements
- have not got NZ and Australian Government Scholarship in the last 24 months in the time of application
- have an IELTS score of average 6.5 with each band min 6 for post graduate study (may be higher)
- etc

# What do scholarship cover ?

- Full tuition fees
- Travel costs
- An establishment and living allowance
- Medical and travel insurance
- Pastoral and academic support



# Some scholars may also be eligible for

- Home located research grant, home leave, and compassionate travel
- Introductory programmes prior to starting formal academic study
- A contribution towards research and thesis costs
- Additional tutorial assistance if required
- A work visa and access to employment
- New Zealand primary and secondary education for dependents.

# Shortlisting and awarding process

# Assessment Criteria:

- Development priorities
- Work Experience
- Gender Equity
- High academic results
- Leadership potential

## Cont...

- All applicants will be notified whether they are shortlisted or unsuccessful.
- Shortlisted Scholarship applicants: proceed to an interview and or undertake English language tests.
- Successful candidates are informed in October and November each year.

# University's Scholarship

# Victoria University of Wellington

- Master (by thesis) scholarship: up to 30 awardees a year, \$15000 + domestic fees, tenure of award one year
- PhD scholarship: 105 awardees a year (three batches: 1 March, 1 July and 1 November with 35 awardees each), \$23,500 stipend annually + tuition fees

# Cont...

## # University of Auckland

- Master Thesis (Faculty of Arts): up to 10 awardees a year \$5000, tenure of award one year, see other faculties
- Doctoral Scholarship: tuition fees and provides an annual allowance of NZ\$25,000, in the form of a fortnightly stipend.
