Skimming & Scanning





• is a strategies that used to quickly identify the main ideas of a text.

•Skimming is done at a speed three to four times faster than normal reading.

When might you use skimming? In what situations is it useful?



• When we have a great deal of material to read in **a short** amount of **time**

useful when you want to quickly gain an overview or familiarize yourself with a chapter or an article to understand the structure for later note-making.

useful when you're seeking specific information rather than reading for comprehension.



Scanning

 is what you do when you are searching for particular information

• Scanning works well to find dates, names, and places.

• A technique you often use when looking up a word in the telephone book or dictionary. You search for key words or ideas.

• When they are scanning, they move their eyes to find specific words, numbers or phrases.

How to do scanning

 Run your finger down the page to keep your eyes focusing on the search for key words

• Look for words that are bold faced, italics, or in a different font size, style, or color.
