Reading Passage

THE RISE OF YOUNG MOSLEM SCHOLARS



There are numbers of young Moslem **Scholars** or clerics, *ulama*, appear on the Social media such as: YouTube, Tweeters, Instagram etc. Thanks to the easy access of the social media, their appearances can also be said as an indicator that many people have got fast access to the religious teaching. The term convert or *Hijrah* has taken place into some kind of a life style that many people are now becoming aware of their

religion. Therefore, names such as: ustadz Abdul Somad, ustadz Adi Hidayat, ustadz Bachtiar Nasir, ustadz Abdullah Hadrami, ustadz Felix Siauw, and many others can be said as young and popular Moslem scholars whose teachings can **embrace** many people especially the **youngsters**. Each of the study or discussion conducted by them can be **attended** by hundreds or even thousands of people gathering in order to listen to their lectures and studies. Most of them are millennial **congregations** who attend to these young Moslem scholars.

One of the most **prominent** is ustadz Adi Hidayat. He graduated from Kuliyya Dakwah Islamiyah Libya by studying intensively from various disciplines related to the Qur'an, Hadith, Fiqh, Ushul Fiqh, Lughah, and so on. His love for the Qur'an and Hadith made him to take the special program of Lughah Arabiyyah wa Adabuha or the study of Arabic language in order to understand the depth of the meaning of these two sources of Shari'a or Islamic Law. He is able to explain both Al Qur'an and Hadits very clearly as well as constructively so that his lecture and study can be sharp and interesting. As a result, many people like his lecture or tausiah. The smart and in-depth review can be delivered well to his congregations.

Same as ustadz Adi Hidayat, another prominent young Islamic scholar is ustadz Felix Siauw. Though he is a mualaf, or a person who converted to Islam, ustadz Felix's knowledge in Islam is better than other newly converted Moslem. His **comprehension** in understanding Islam is used to **widespread** his lecture so that he can inspire many people to be the true followers of Islam. He believes that preaching or dakwah is about how to get people go straight in the right path. His method of preaching is also easy to follow and understand by other Moslems.

A. Definition of Report Text

Report is used to provide information about an event or situation based on the report or systematic investigation and observation or to describe an event as the way it is. The communicative purpose of this text is to give information based on the facts. It is started with the classification of the general aspect of an event, phenomena, things such as animal, wild life, or society. Then the description of this text can include general aspects as they are also used in the descriptive text. The use of noun, proper noun as well as adjective and adverb are used to describe the quality, the characteristics, and the situation of a phenomenon.

Report is also used to convey information related to the natural phenomena, nature of a wild life as well as the socio-cultural phenomena happened in the real life. Hence this text is a scientific based report or can be based on a journalistic observation and report investigation. Thus, the generic is divided into: general classification and description.
